

Objectives of the ESF+

Main instrument to invest in people & implement the principles of the European Pillar of Social Rights

- Reforms to improve economic and social resilience, upward social convergence, health policies. Better alignment of programming with CSRs.
- Investing in education and skills, promoting employment, notably for youth and LTU
- Integration of migrants
- Social inclusion, fight against poverty and inequality, high level of health protection
- Labour mobility and social innovation
- More equal access to health, cross border health threats

Call for Proposals: Pilot Joint Action Plan

- Complementary set of actions to address a challenge identified in the pilot JAP area
- > Reimbursement based on outputs and/or results
- > Areas linked to country-specific recommendations of that Member State relevant to the ESF in the area of Thematic Objectives 8, 9 and 10, LTU, Youth Employment, Migrants, Skills Agenda
- > Submission of proposals by 19th July 2018
- > Budget approx. € 2,3 mill, up to 90% co-financing, 1-3 proposals
